## Teams meet to prepare for GAFCON

An international team helping Kenya's local committee organise the second Global Anglican Future Conference (GAFCON) has met in Nairobi. The massive undertaking will see more than 1,000 delegates converge on the Kenyan capital in October. They will gather at the new function centre at All Saints Cathedral, a venue that the GAFCON Chairman, the Primate of Kenya, Archbishop Eliud Wabukala calls 'an act of providence'. The main hall accommodates more than 2,000 people and there are smaller rooms which will host a variety of workshops during the

conference. The international team, headed by Bishop Martyn Minns, will help the local team liaise with international delegations, such as the hundreds of people coming from Nigeria and others from the rest of Africa, the UK, the US, Asia, Australia and the Pacific.
