Archbishop speaks about Nairobi, 21-26th October 2013

Choice of location 'important'

The Primate of Kenya, and Chairman of GAFCON/FCA Archbishop Eliud Wabukala has spoken about the choice of Kenya as the venue for GAFCON 2013, calling it a significant reminder of the East Africa revival. The Archbishop was speaking with just under 3 months before the start of the conference at All Saints Cathedral. "This is a very important event for the world" the Archbishop said. "There is a need right now in the whole world for re-evangelisation. For a new way to speak the gospel with joy to everybody." In a video posted on the GAFCON

website, Archbishop Eliud spoke of the martyrs who had died in Africa for the truth of the Gospel. "I think there is a little complacency about it and therefore our meeting here should remind us of our forefathers who died for this faith" he said.
