Chairman says Nairobi 2013 meeting 'another wonderful and historic occasion'

In his August letter to members of the GFCA, GAFCON chairman Archbishop Eliud Wabukala gave an update on preparations for the second Global Anglican Future conference. "I am confident that this will be another wonderful and historic occasion" the Archbishop said. "Many of those who shared in the fellowship of our first gathering in Jerusalem remarked that it had been a once in a lifetime experience, but I believe that GAFCON 2013 will be equally memorable, yet in a

different way." Work is well advanced on the programme, which will include 'mini-conferences' on topics such as economic empowerment and the church, gospel proclamation and culture, marriage, family and sexuality, theological education, and engaging with Islam.
