A number of key topics facing Anglican churches around the world are to be discussed at the second Global Anglican Future Conference at Nairobi's All Saints Cathedral and Conference Centre from 21st to 26th October. Nine mini-conferences have been arranged for delegates including topics such as youth, Gospel and culture, aid and development and marriage and family. 'The challenge of Islam' will be explored in a group facilitated by Bishop Michael Nazir-Ali. GAFCON reports will include the outcome of

the mini-conferences as well as a conference communique. Delegates will attend a single strand throughout their time in Nairobi, in order to deeply explore the issue and produce significant statements on each theme. Material and resources will be posted at gafcon.org.
