Country delegations prepare for Nairobi 2013

Country and region delegations have stepped up their preparation for GAFCON 2013, now just one month away. Meetings in London and Sydney have briefed participants on arrangements and delegates from around the world are finalising travel plans. More than 100 will travel from England, Wales and Ireland and a briefing of the group heard from GAFCON Chairman Archbishop Wabukala and a video hookup between Australia, South Africa and Nigeria. Nigerian Bishop Ben Kwashi spoke of the rejoicing just

hours after the release of kidnapped Archbishop Ignatius Kattey and said Nigerians looked forward to coming to GAFCON in large numbers. Archbishop Kattey will be among the 370 strong delegation which includes the Primate, 170 Bishops and all 14 Nigerian Archbishops.
