Nigeria. Pray for the Church of Nigeria as it prepares for the election of a new Primate this year.

Thursday 28th March

Tanzania. Bishop Mwita Akiri writes: Pray that more church leaders, especially Bishops will understand fully the danger of liberal agenda in the Church and stand firm against it.

Friday 29th March

Uganda. Archbishop Stanley Ntagali has stated on numerous occasions that Uganda's problems are fundamentally spiritual issues. The people of Uganda live under a yoke of systemic corruption that undermines many human rights and people's access to basic services, especially health care and justice. Pray for the Church of Uganda to faithfully proclaim the Gospel and that the Holy Spirit's conviction of sin would lead to repentance and the pursuit of righteousness.
