

Wednesday 3rd April

The Gafcon Women's Ministry Network. Pray for good communication amongst the senior women leaders of this network. There is a plan for a possible conference of senior women leaders in Kenya, for mobilisation and strategic planning for the future of women in ministry in Gafcon.

Thursday 4th April

Uganda. Please pray for children to grow up in physically, emotionally, and spiritually safe homes, schools, and communities and that they will grow in "wisdom and stature, and in favour with God and man." (Luke 2.52) Pray for the Church of Uganda's 37 Dioceses and 5,000 schools to promote the Year of Children in such a way that families and children will be transformed through the love of Jesus Christ.

Friday 5th April

The Gafcon Bishops Training Institute. There has been the demand to spread out the BTI Training Conference venues. So, there are considerations of having some future BTI Training Conferences in Brazil, Australia and other places to make it easy to meet different contexts. We value your prayer for God's wisdom.

Saturday 6th April

Tanzania. Pray for the formation of a Gafcon branch in Tanzania to provide a link with orthodox leaders and Christians in the Anglican Communion.

Monday 8th April

Tanzania. Pray for the availability of resources for orthodox theological training at all levels.

Tuesday 9th April

Gafcon Ireland. Pray for the Gafcon Ireland Council as it prepares to meet on the 3 April; for gospel unity, for biblical focus and clarity, and for wisdom in planning future events and projects. Gafcon Ireland has four key aims: to PROCLAIM the crucified and risen Christ; to PARTNER with others who love the Lord; to PLANT new congregations; and to PREPARE believers for ministry. The Council and Executive is currently working out how to turn these commitments into practical long-term realities. Pray that this will be done effectively, wisely and with a dependence on the Lord.
